Role Overview

You will provide proof of concept and see through to off-site Factory Acceptance Testing including full Audio, Video & Networking functionality of systems to meet project specification. This role involves and is not limited to provide management of a team, administrative, technical and logistical works.

Key Responsibilities

- > Manage the full process, from acceptance of systems into Off-site Commissioning delivering off-site Factory Acceptance Tests
- > Leadership of the Off-site Commissioning team ensuring they have comprehensive understanding of the demands for each assignment, along with timeframes and schedules of work
- > Technical leadership and planning for all tasks assigned
- > Delivery of multiple, simultaneous projects and managerial tasks whilst adhering to key milestones and deadlines
- > Creating & maintaining on-going communications with all internal & external stakeholders, project teams, consultants & customers to subcontractors
- > Support of the team when projects appear challenging and provide guidance for less experienced team members and juniors
- > Monitor and report on the technical progress on all required deliverables for Off-site staging.
- > Forecast & Manage resource (and any associated sub-contract cost) throughout the entirety of each project
- > Provide detailed technical requirements for each project
- > Represent the company with the necessary level of professional conduct and presentation and completion of work to agreed standard
- > Reporting, fault-finding & problem solving at a technical and resource level
- > Drive a culture of continuous improvement throughout the business and promote a mind-set of personal accountability

- > Proven team-leader, who can exercise an authoritative leadership method whilst maintaining an approachable, team-spirited culture.
- > DSP programming on all major DSP platforms, with the ability to fully design and configure systems. This must include a verifiable working knowledge of QSC Q-sys products, BiAmp Tesira & Forte, Yamaha DSP and Mixing equipment, Dante L1 – L3, Shure certification as a minimum.
- > An excellent and thorough technical knowledge of Audio-visual and Networked Systems
- > Extensive understanding of advanced Networking practices with the ability to integrate into an AV environment.
